Feed Bag Policy Update

Hinton Mills is no longer able to refill used feed bags

Our number one priority is the safety of our customers and team members. The COVID-19 pandemic has caused us to reevaluate our safety protocol and our compliance with the FDA's Food Safety Modernization Act. It is necessary for us to continue to make changes to better serve you while looking out for the safety and health of customers, team and communities.

We will no longer be able to refill used feed bags (of any size). All bagged feed will be put in new Hinton Mills feed bags.

We believe this policy change will help keep customers and team members safe by:

- Helping to maintain recommended distancing
- Limiting contact/personal interaction
- Reducing time on site

To best achieve this goal and make ordering feed most efficient for you, we ask you to call in advance to place orders and allow our team adequate time to prepare your feed and have it

ready to put on your truck when you arrive. For efficiency and due to our limited storage space, please indicate your preferred timeframe that you'd like to pick up your order. As always, we will accommodate the best we can.

Furthermore, it will be helpful to call again before you leave home to make sure your order is ready. The best practice is to give our team a preferred number to call when your order is in the mixer/ready. If you make billing arrangements during your call, all we will have to do is load your order when you arrive.

Bags are currently \$.30 each (approximately \$10-12 per ton depending on mix). Hinton Mills has a variety of other feed options that may better fit your specific needs at this time. In some cases, one of our pre-packaged Hinton Mills branded products (such as Blue Ribbon), ton bags, feed in a gravity wagon/grain cart, or bulk delivery may suit your needs better.

For added convenience and to further limit your time on site, your feed order



can be placed on pallets for easy loading/unloading. You can bring in pallets to trade with us when you arrive or pay \$5 each for pallets.

Your continued business is appreciated more than you could possibly know. Above this, the health and safety of each customer and team member is our highest priority. Thank you for your patience during this unusual time.

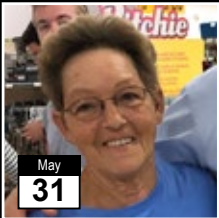

Kids & Dogs Take Over Hinton Mills Facebook Page

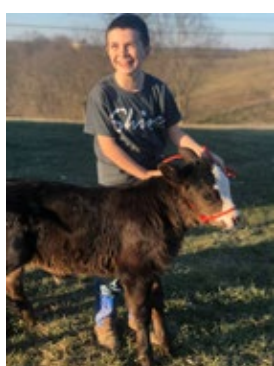
