1. A cover crop of any variety reduces soil nutrient loss and adds organic matter. See us for low cost cleaned cover crop wheat.
2. Save on your 2024 corn and soybeans by taking advantage of the early pay discounts that are now available. See stores for details.
3. Scout your harvested fields for problematic weeds to appropriately plan for next year.
4. Bring us your soil test samples. We will send them off to get your results and formulate recommendations to help you plan for proper levels of fertilizer for the coming season.
