Freezer Beef Mix Helps Producers Hit Quality, Harvest Targets

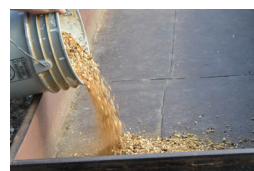
Bourbon County beef cattle farmer Andrew Fritsch has been finishing out beef for his and his neighbor's freezers for his entire life.

"We always feed out 2-4 steers a year. Quality is everything to us. We pride our farm on producing top-quality beef," said Fritsch.

"Last year, we had four steers that I needed to finish by October 1. We were feeding them Blue Ribbon, but as fall got closer, I realized they needed a little boost to get them where I wanted them to be by their harvest date. I

called Matt Watson at Jabetown Mill, and he suggested this Freezer Beef mix.

We started feeding it about 90 days before slaughter. The cattle ate it good, and it worked. I think especially in that last 45 days, we saw a big jump in their gain. All four finished between 1100 and 1400 pounds. Our target weight is 1200, so we were pleased. It's become our go-to for finishing. We've got two more that we'll harvest this fall who are on it right now."

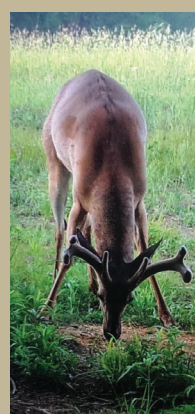

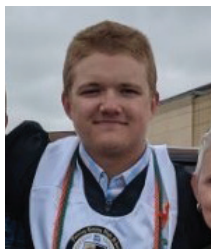
