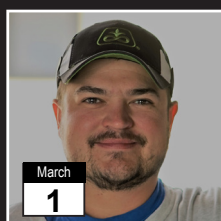

However, what made the event most special to us was our opportunity to visit with customers about the right plan and products they need this spring for their unique farming operations.

Hinton Mills Cynthiana Location has Unique Agricultural History, Receives Important Upgrades for this Season

Hinton Mills came to Cynthiana in 2016, holding our grand opening on March 25th of that year. However, the site of Hinton Mills Cynthiana location has a long history of agricultural endeavors that predates our arrival in Harrison County.

According to Cynthiana resident Mr. James Gaunce, who worked at the facility for 22 years starting in 1957, the property was first used for agribusiness by Gene Van Deren and Osmer Deming. Van Deren and Deming owned Bluegrass Plant Foods, Inc. and was operating out of the location at time of their incorporation on June 28, 1948. The pair also incorporated Cardinal Seed Company, Inc. on the property on January 10, 1958.

There are tons of interesting tidbits we've found about those companies. Mr. Gaunce remembered times when the company used sticks of dynamite to break up the piles of phosphate and potash (but not near the explosive nitrogen). He also remembered tobacco being warehoused on the property, as well as the existing lower warehouse being built in 1962. Former UK Basketball Coach Joe B. Hall's father was one of the salesmen for Bluegrass Plant Foods at one time.

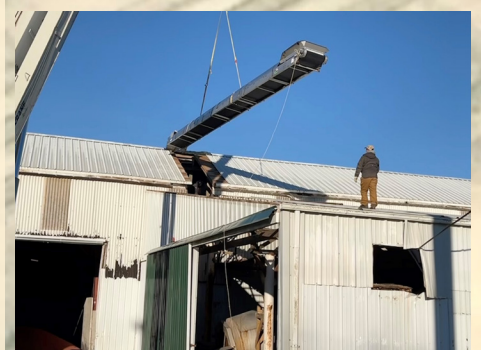
The next owner of the location was Burley Belt Chemical Company who operated out of the plant in the mid to late 1970s into the 1980s. Cargill (Minnetonka, MN) owned the facility when Dwight Leslie, manager of Hinton Mills Cynthiana, first started to work at the location in 1989. Cargill sold to Miles Farm Supply (Owensboro, KY) in 1998. Miles eventually sold to Crop Production Services (Loveland, CO). Hinton Mills acquired the property at 332 Lincoln Avenue from CPS in February of 2016.

Like our facility, the Cynthiana community has a storied history of agriculture. To continue to be able to serve the hard-working farm families in the area and help them continue to build on their agricultural heritage for years to come, we have invested in various new equipment this winter. Upgrades include a new fertilizer blender, updated electrical services, expanded truck and rail loading and unloading, and increased fertilizer storage capacity. These changes allow us to give you more efficient, faster service. It also enables us to have more dependable supply of ingredients during a time that is full of supply challenges.

Our goal continues to be accommodating the needs of local farmers. We hope these upgrades will help us accomplish these goals and show you that we are committed to Cynthiana for the long-term. Thank you for continuing to allow us to earn your business and create our own stories together!
