We appreciate the fact that you have chosen Hinton Mills for your farm supply needs. Here are just a few things that may help you get the quickest, most efficient service.

- Whenever possible, call in advance to let us know you're coming. It allows us to have your order ready when you arrive.
- The minimum order for customer-mixed feed is 1,000 lbs., whether you're ordering it bagged or in bulk.
- We will have custom-mixed feed orders ready by noon the day after you call in the order.
- For bulk deliveries, especially if there's a holiday that week or bad weather is in the forecast, please give us as much notice as possible.
- You can return your pallets to any Hinton Mills location
- It's getting to be feed delivery season. Please check the ladders on your feed bins - for your safety and ours!

Why Still Curbside Service?

When the Covid-19 pandemic hit, we decided to close our showrooms to walk-in customers and instead, serve you curbside. What we thought would be a few weeks of curbside service turned into a few months...and then a few more.

We can't thank you enough for your patience and flexibility while we adjusted to the new protocols. Likewise, we want to publicly acknowledge and thank our team for the way they have been all-in on getting customers what they need, when they need it, no matter what the challenges.

We have had a few folks ask when we think we'll re-open our showrooms, and as much as we'd like to give you a date, the truth is, we still don't know.

There are two factors that are driving our decision to remain with curbside service for now:

1-Protecting the health of our team and our customers. Our employees are our most valuable resource. We have take care of them to take care of you. Anything we can do to help reduce their risk of infection is an important step for us.

2-Protecting our ability to fully serve you. Beyond being great places to visit and pick up your farm supplies, each of our five locations serves a unique role in fulfilling the overall supply chain that is Hinton Mills. For instance, certain feeds are bagged only at one location, then distributed between all stores. Whether it's logistics or milling, if one store goes down, all are affected.

We do have a plan in place if the worst happens and we have to quarantine a location. We've seen it happen locally to others in our sector, so as much as we'd like to avoid it, we have put pencil to paper and are ready to keep service disruptions at a minimum in the case of such an event.

However, our number one goal is continuing to serve you efficiently and effectively so you can get on about your business. Right now, for us, that means continuing with curbside service.

We are just as ready to see you in our showrooms as you are ready to be there. Until then, stay safe, call ahead for quicker service, and thank you for being a customer of Hinton Mills.
