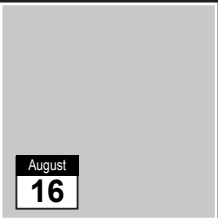
Joe Jolly and his dad June had a hand in the construction of the mill in 1968. They helped install the 4,000 gallon molasses tank that is still in use today.
