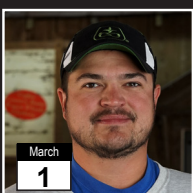

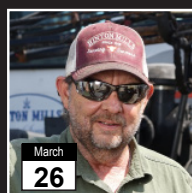

Poison Hemlock is toxic to a wide variety of animals. March is the best time of year for herbicide treatment. In grass pastures and hayfields herbicide products containing 2,4-D can be effective when applied to young, actively growing plants.
